With safety our first priority, we have had to cancel:

- Ice Car Races. The banks on the tracks are not staying solid enough to ensure the cars stay inside the track.
- The Aircraft Ice Fly-in and Flying Tours.
- Rebel Racing Sled Drags

Please note, the ice is still safe with 26-31" of ice.

There is slush and water on the lake. We recommend you wear footwear that is waterproof and with good grips; like rubber boots and ice cleats.

Each tent has a floor.

LAC LA BICHE LAKE: JEWEL OF THE NORTH

The thing that makes the Lac La Biche Ice Festival a stand out event is the jewel of the event; Lac La Biche lake. Lac La Biche Lake is historically and culturally significant.

The indigenous Cree people referred to the lake as "Waskesiu Sakahegan," meaning "Elk Lake."

The name "Lac La Biche" translates to "Lake of the Doe" in French, referring to female deer.

It ranks as the seventh-largest lake in the province, covering an area of about 91 square miles (236 square kilometers).

The lake features an average depth of approximately 27.6 feet (8.4 meters) and reaches a maximum depth of about 79.8 feet (24.4 meters).

Lac La Biche is fed by several rivers, including the Owl River, Plamondon Creek, and Red Deer Brook, with the La Biche River serving as its sole outflow, connecting to the Athabasca River.

The lake is home to several islands, the largest of which is Churchill Island, located within Sir Winston Churchill Provincial Park. This park offers a variety of recreational activities, such as fishing, boating, hiking, and nature appreciation. The lake's diverse shoreline, which includes sandy beaches and forested areas, enhances its appeal as a recreational destination.

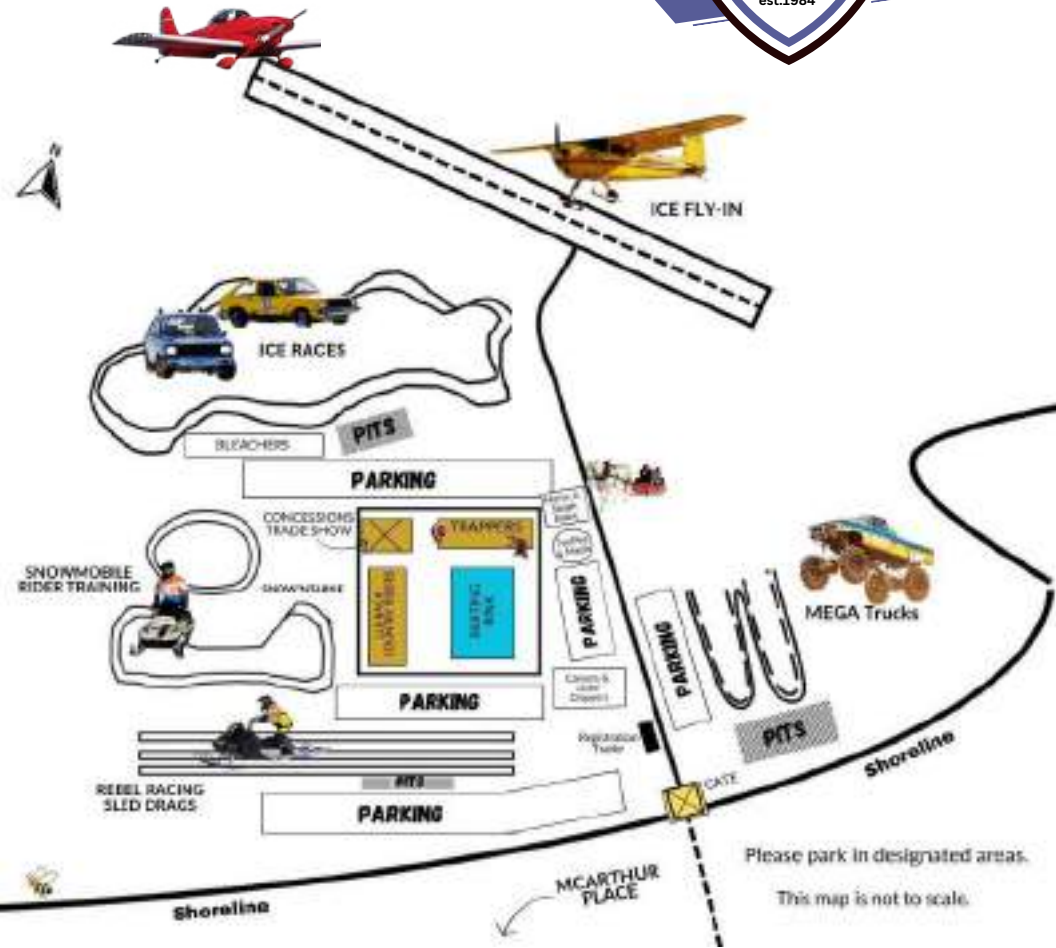

WHAT IS ICE RACING? GET READY FOR THE THRILL!

Imagine the rush of controlling a car, skidding and drifting at high speed across a vast frozen lake. That's ice racing—an electrifying sport that's a true test of driving skill. For those who have the guts and nerve to brave the slippery surface, it's an exhilarating experience, with a perfect blend of speed, precision, and sheer adrenaline. But don't be fooled; it's not all about going fast. The ice has a way of humbling even the most seasoned drivers. A single mistake, even the smallest slip-up, can cost precious time—or worse, send you crashing into snowbanks or other competitors. It's an unforgiving sport that demands the utmost respect.

Safety Comes First

When it comes to ice racing, safety isn't just a suggestion—it's a must. Every car at the Western Canadian Ice Racing Championships, held at the thrilling Lac La Biche Ice Festival, is rigorously scrutinized to meet the strict safety standards set by the Northern Alberta Sports Car Club (NASCC) and the Western Canada Motorsports Association (WCMA). Whether you're racing in an entry-level Chevette class or a seasoned track car, all vehicles must come equipped with a roll cage, five-point seat harness, and a window net to ensure drivers stay protected while tearing up the ice.

But that's not all. Ice racing is just one element of a bigger motorsport world. Both the NASCC and WCMA also host thrilling summer racing events, keeping adrenaline junkies on the edge of their seats year-round.
